The *Database of State Incentives for Renewables & Efficiency* (DSIRE) is the nation's most comprehensive source of information on federal, state, local and utility incentives and policies that promote renewable energy and energy efficiency. Established in 1995, DSIRE is an ongoing project of the N.C. Solar Center and the Interstate Renewable Energy Council. DSIRE, a public resource, is funded by the U.S. Department of Energy.

Key Features

- **An Interactive U.S. Map** allows quick access to state solar program information.
- **A Solar Policy Guide** describes various types of policies adopted by state and local governments to encourage solar. This resource for state policy makers and other stakeholders details the status and trends of individual policies, provides examples of specific programs, and includes links to additional resources.
- **Summary Maps** provide a geographical overview of the availability of solar policies and incentives across the country.
- **Solar Policy Comparison Tables** highlight individual elements of solar rebate programs and tax credits to facilitate comparison among state programs.
- **A Search Feature** allows users to create a custom list of programs by solar technology, incentive type, eligible sector or other criteria.
